Second Edition (2002), Global Complexity (2003), Performing Tourist Places (2004), Mobilities, Networks, Geographies (2006), Mobilities (2007), After the Car (2009). He is currently writing Mobile Lives, co-editing a journal special issue on Global Heating and co-editing a book on Mobile Methods.
